INTRODUCTION

Special Camp Programme: - It is an integral part of NSS activities. It provides opportunities to our youth for group living, sharing of experience with each other and constant interaction with community. Special Camping was organized generally on various developmental and social issues of National importance. The theme of NSS has been changed from time to time and at present our theme is "HEALTH, & ENERGY CONSERVATION". Every year 50% of the volunteers of each NSS unit are expected to participate in special camps which is of 7 days.

1. **Day 1, 06-03-2021** The Special camp NSS Volunteers from 5th Semester Electrical & Electronics Engineering participated brainstorms session from 09.30am to 12.00 noon. The volunteers framed 06 groups and named their groups. They discussed on planning and execution with respect to energy conservation awareness, Covid-19 SOP, Cleaning in the camp area and breast cancer awareness. The groups prepared placards in Kannada. Volunteers also finalized on the contents for the handouts regarding energy conservation. The NSS volunteer T-Shirts were distributed.
2. **Day 2, 07-03-2021:-** Our NSS Volunteers prepared a data sheet to collect the information from the households regarding the energy consumption. Sufficient numbers of print outs of data sheets and handouts were taken. The work on placards were completed. (You can add further details to this)
3. **Day 3, 08-03-2021:-** We visited Awerahalli village. It is a village in Magadi taluk in Ramanagara District, 37 km away from Bengaluru city. The Special camp Inauguration programme started at 10-30 am with an invocation song from NSS Volunteers. Guest of Honour **Sri. Mallanna**, Member of Grama Panchayath, Awerahalli, **Sri Narayana Swamy**, President of Fisheries, Awerahalli, **Smt. Saraswathi**, Secretary of Fisheries, Awerahalli were present. 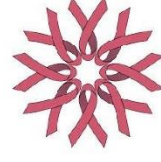

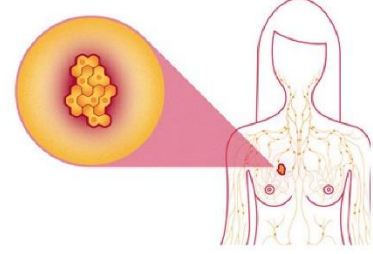

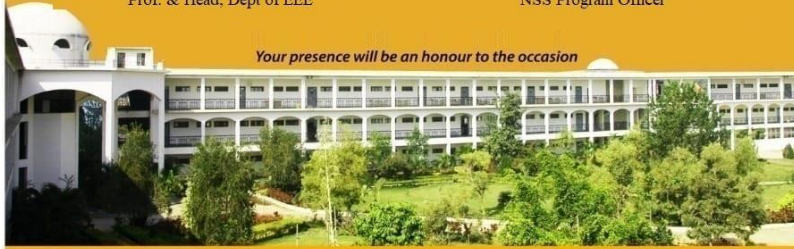
