ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Objectives:

Anti-ragging committee (ARC) is responsible to nullify ragging in the campus and to discuss about the problems occurred in the campus and resolve the issues raised from the students by Anti-ragging committee. Anti-ragging committee should maintain superior relations with the students.

Roles of Anti Ragging Committee:

As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

1. A few act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.
2. Unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.
3. Act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity.
4. Activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm or creates Fear or Apprehension.
5. Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.
6. Act of Wrongful Confinement, committing unnatural offences, trespass or intimidation.
7. Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc.
8. Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health.

Punishment to those found guilty

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments



1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
2. Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits
3. Debarring from appearing in any sessional test / University Examination
4. Suspension from the college for a period of one month

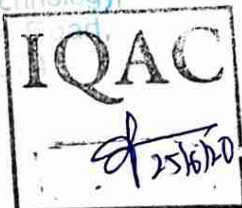
Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Committee

1. The functions of ARC will be to keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of Student aggregation including, Classrooms, Canteens, Buses, Grounds, Hostels etc.
2. The ARC will also educate the students by adopting various means about the troublemaker of Ragging and related Punishments.
3. An extent of positive reinforcement activities are adopted by ARC for orienting students and shaped their personality for a better reason.

Duties of the Anti Ragging Committee

1. To ensure the display of posters/tabs on Main and Departmental Notice Boards and other places such as Library, Sports, canteen, Lounge, Gymnasium, Bus stops and other prominent designated places.
2. To be vigilant at all hours including at odd hours all around the Campus and other places vulnerable to incidents of, and having the potential of, ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
3. Conduct anonymous random surveys among fresher's to check whether the Campus is indeed free from ragging.
4. Also to monitor the welfare of fresh students outside the campus.

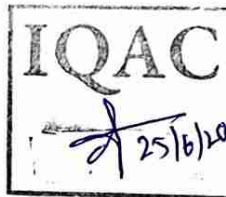


ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Standard Operating Procedure of Anti Ragging Committee

- Anti Ragging Committee (ARC) is constituted by nominating faculty from each Department and a WhatsApp group is created by the convener for effective communication with ARC members.
- Rooms allocated to new entrants in the hostel are identified and interaction shall be made with them to make campus free from Ragging.
- ARC team for different locations is made containing time slots and faculty assigned for them. This arrangement is circulated to all faculty members involved in monitoring anti ragging.
- Susceptible points of ragging are identified in campus, hostel, canteen, etc.
- The visited staff members should be signs in the registers kept at hostels and convener office.
- Regular meetings are conducted to do effective monitoring of ARC.
- The display boards containing names and contact numbers of ARC are placed in the campus.
- Boards containing information on severe consequences of ragging are displayed in prominent places campus.
- Undertakings are collected from all students and their parents stating that they/their ward do not indulge in ragging.
- Compliance of anti-ragging procedures are followed is updated in MHRD web site.
- Students are cautioned periodically to stay away from the troublemaker of ragging.
